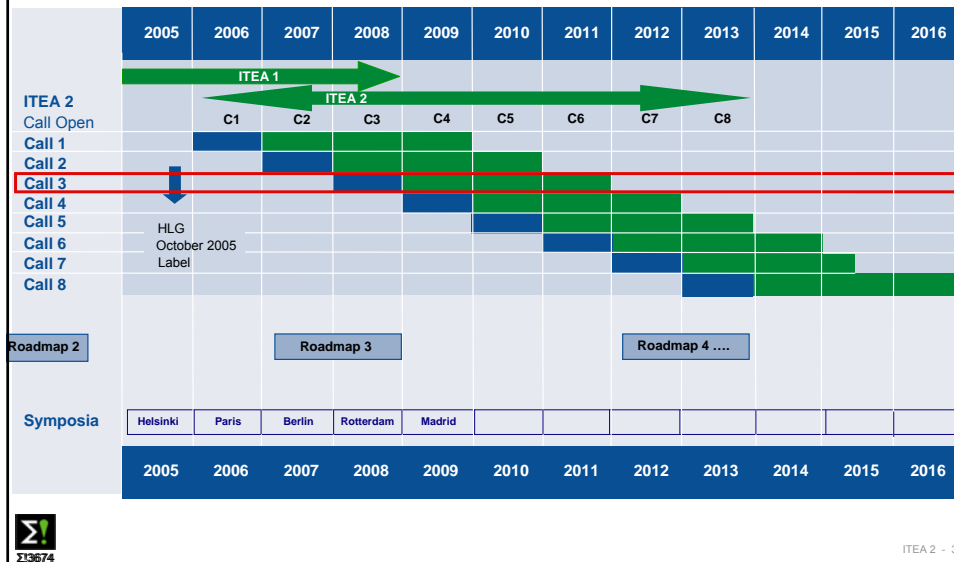

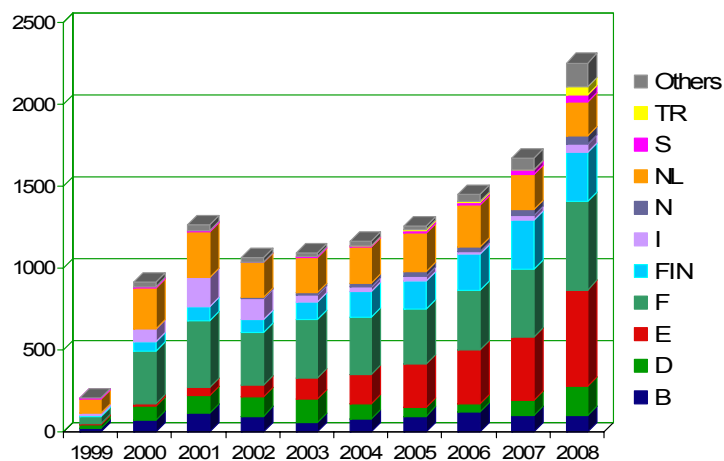

ITEA & ITEA 2 FPP Effort per country All FPP - #PY, status August 2008

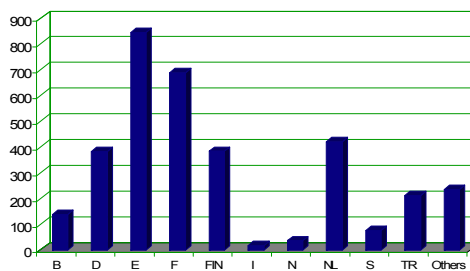
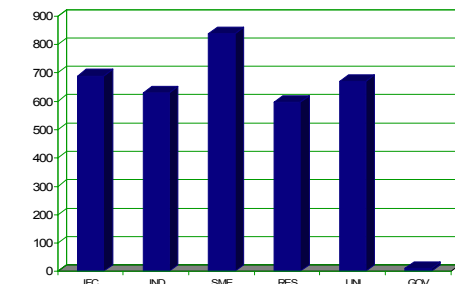


ITEA 2 Call 3: POs invited for FPP

ITEA 2 Call 3*:

- 27 POs proposed
- 21 POs invited for FPP
Total of 3434 PY
- 21 countries in total
- 25 % of PY in SMEs
- Turkey at #6 in POs

* PO deadline: April 11,
FPP deadline: October 31

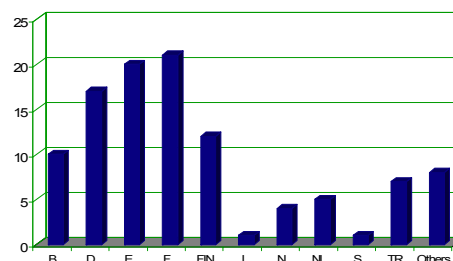

The ITEA 2 community Strongly growing ecosystems

- An average ITEA 2 project consortium consists of ~2 big partners and ~10 smaller ones
- Over the total lifetime of the ITEA/ITEA 2 programme up to ITEA 2 Call 2, we have seen approximately 800 different partners

- Total number of SMEs in Call 2 for the first time over 100
- Especially in France, Spain, Germany, many SME partners:

- ITEA 2 Call 3 has in total 280 partners (120 SMEs):
 - 170 of these partners (90 SMEs) - 60 % - are new to ITEA and ITEA 2
 - 32 of these partners - 11 % - have participated over 6 times in an ITEA project before



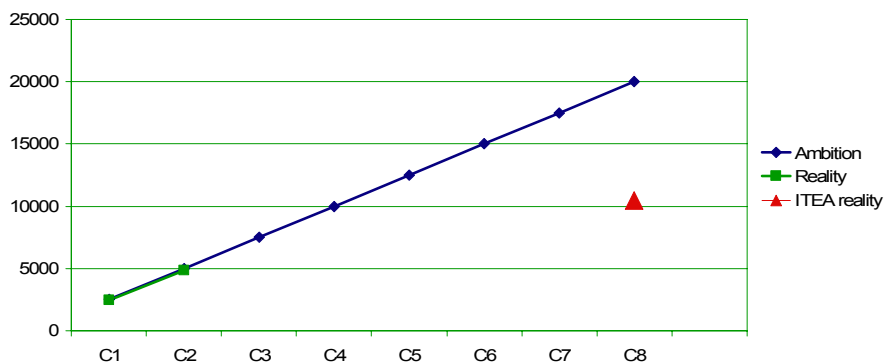

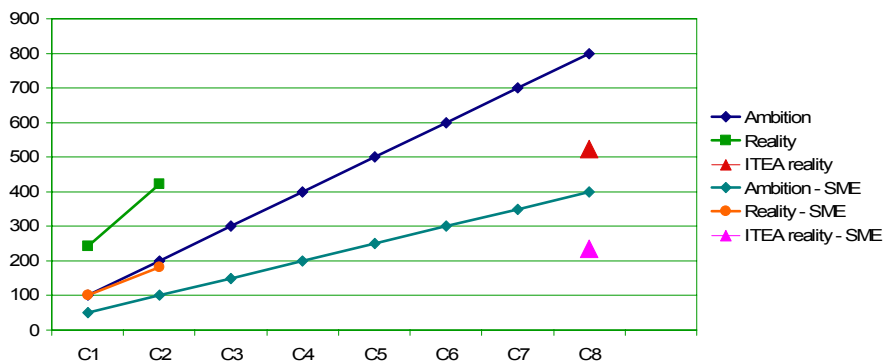
ITEA 2 key indicators and targets (1) All FPP, status August 2008, Calls 1-2

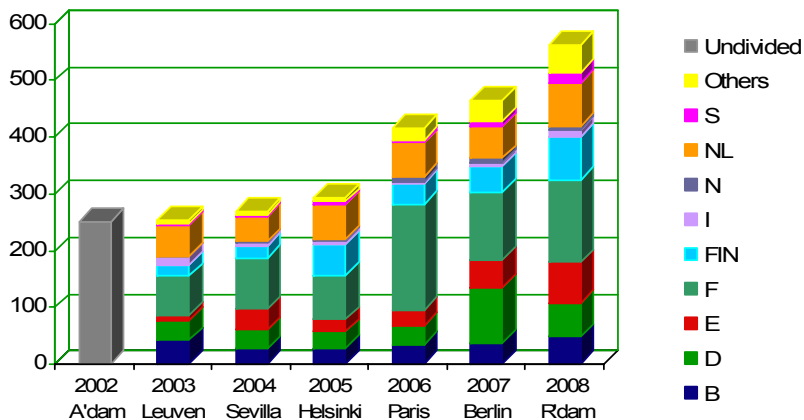


ITEA & ITEA 2 Symposia 2002 – 2008 Attendance per country

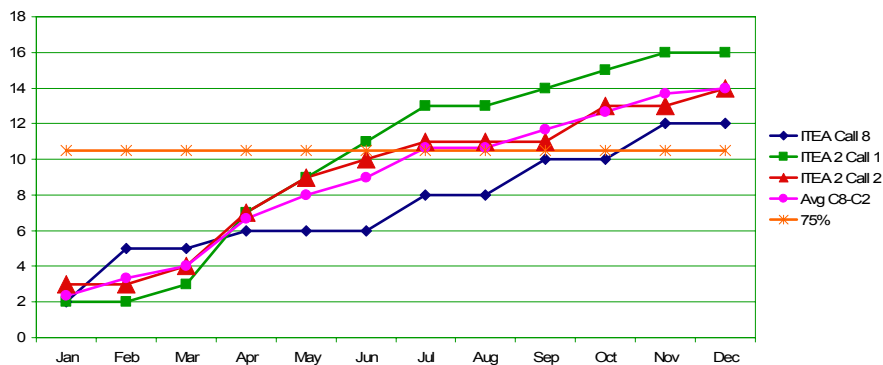
Efficiency of ITEA 2 Lead time to start of project

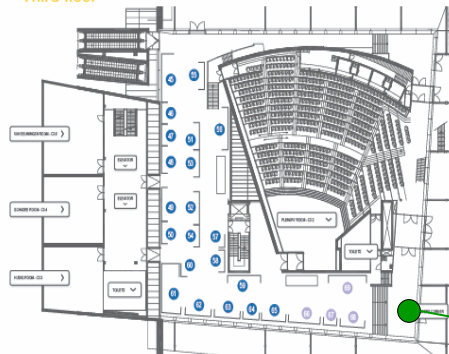

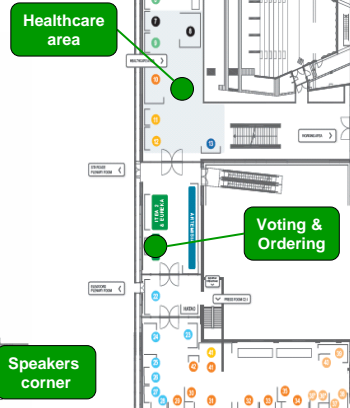

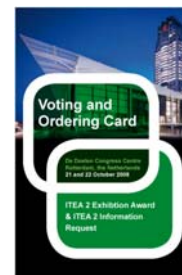
